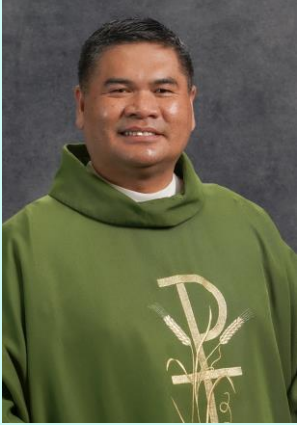


A Snapshot
